

# Annual Contact Lens Agreement

At Inland Eye Care, we want your contact lens fitting experience to be a positive one thus we aim to make our contact lens policies simple and fair to everyone. We carry the latest in contact lens technology, and specialize in the difficult to fit patients. This includes astigmatism-correcting lenses (Toric), multifocal lenses, corneal diseases (like keratoconus) and post-surgical contact lens fits.

A **Contact Lens Evaluation** is necessary to renew the current contact lens prescription and is in addition to the comprehensive eye exam fee. This evaluation will include precise measurements of your eyes, analysis of your vision needs, and recommendations specifically tailored to you. It may also include the use of diagnostic lenses if necessary by our doctors to ensure the proper fit of the lenses and good ocular health. Contact lenses are a wonderful way to correct the vision that can provide freedom from wearing glasses, but they are medical devices. They should be worn for the duration and in the manner specified by the doctor. If this is not followed it can lead to infection, swelling, severe irritation, possibly permanent vision loss, and blindness.

- It is required that all contact lens fits and follow-ups be completed **within 90 days** unless your insurance company has different stipulations or other unique circumstances arise. If this requirement is not fulfilled, the fitting fee must be re-paid.
- Before a prescription can be issued and finalized, all requisite follow-ups must be completed. Contact lens prescriptions are valid for **1 year**.
- Every insurance plan is different, thus please understand the fees associated with using your insurance. Any amount not covered by your insurance is your responsibility.
- It is a requirement that ALL contact lens wearers have a pair of spectacles that provide legal vision for driving.
- If necessary, it will also include the cost of any addition contact lens training classes needed for those individuals needing contact lens instructions for insertion, removal and lens care.

The Contact Lens Fit Evaluation/Re-fit Evaluation fee will range in price depending on the complexity of contact lenses worn and a patient's experience with wearing contact lenses:

- **Standard** Soft spherical ..... \$70-\$80
- **Advanced** Soft toric or astigmatism ..... \$75- \$85
- **Superior** Multifocal or monovision ..... \$80-\$90
- **Medical or specialty** Rigid gas permeable "hard" lenses, irregular corneas ... \$100 and up
